# **UArctic Membership**

- Seven new members joined UArctic (2 Arctic, 5 non-Arctic)
- Nine-member institutions either merged or changed their names, while five members resigned from the network.

### Governance and UArctic Association as Legal entity

#### Assembly Meeting, Copenhagen. February 26, 2020

#### **Future Assembly Meetings**

- Amendment to the UArctic Constitution submitted to the Finnish Patent and Registration authorities to allow meetings of the Assembly to be organized remotely.
- The 2021 Assembly meeting to take place online alongside the UArctic Congress in May
- The 2022 Assembly meeting has been re-scheduled to early June 2022, in Portland, Maine, USA.

#### **Board of UArctic:**

- There were three meetings of the Board in 2020 and all were held online, in April, September, and December.

- UArctic's unrestricted funds budget for 2020 was approved; all agreements and transfer of operational funds were completed;
