When will student receive their acceptance package?	Autumn semester May Spring semester November Letter of Acceptance is issued electronically and arrives by e-mail to the student. It is very important that the e-mail address is correctly written on the application.

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ACCOMMODATION

When can exchange students move in to the University Residence?	Usually when they arrive 1 week before they start the semester.
Is student housing available to exchange students?	Yes.
Cost of on-campus accommodation	From 2 900 SEK/month – 4 000 SEK/month.
When to make payment for the on-campus accommodation?	On arrival.
Withdrawal policy	Three months in advance according to Swedish law.

ARRIVAL/ORIENTATION PROGRAMME

Is Airport Reception available?	Yes. Student who has given information about arrival to LURC will be picked-up during the arrival period. Each student receives information from our student coordinator about housing; arriving; orientation. This information is sent by e-mail so it is very important that the e-mail address to the student is correct and easy to read.
Orientation Programme Details	During orientation International Office offers compulsory academic workshops twice a day, Swedish language course is also offered (3 ECTS) to those who want to take it.

VISA REQUIREMENT/STUDENT'S PASS APPLICATION

What visa should our exchange students apply for?	Contact the nearest Swedish Embassy or Consulate for information about residence/study permit.
What is the visa application process like?	It can take about two months to obtain a residence/study permit. You need; <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A valid passport • A letter of admission • Health insurance valid in Sweden • Documents (bank guarantee etc.) stating that you can meet your living expenses throughout your stay in Sweden. The application can be done online at the Swedish Migration Board's website www.migrationsverket.se/English/Private-individuals/Studying-in-Sweden/Universities-and-university-college.html
