Nomination procedures for partner institutions

- 1. Request access to the Nomination Web**

- 2. Wait for confirmation**
You must receive a confirmation email from  mobility@uit.no before nominating your students.
- 3. Log in to the Online Nomination Web**

- 4. Select the relevant agreement & nominate your student(s)**
Choose the correct **host department** at UiT and the appropriate **exchange programme**.

Nominating student(s) to UNIS (Svalbard)

1. **Students must apply directly to UNIS**
UNIS has its own application system and deadlines, so students must submit their application to UNIS first.
2. **Nominate your student(s) to UiT**
Follow the steps outlined in the “**Nomination procedures for partner institutions**” above.
3. **Students complete the UiT application**
After nomination, UiT will email students with access to the **Application Web (Søknadsweb)**, where they upload their **passport** and **transcript of records**.

Application procedures for exchange students

Exchange for studies

To apply for an exchange programme at **UiT The Arctic University of Norway**, you must complete the following steps:

1. **Be nominated by your home university** under a valid exchange agreement.
2. **Meet the [basic eligibility requirements](#)** for exchange studies at UiT.
3. **Receive an invitation email from UiT** with instructions on how to apply.
4. **Submit your application** through the [Application Web \(Søknadsweb\)](#).
5. **Upload all required documents** as part of your application.

Exchange for traineeships (Non-Medical/Health Sciences)

There are **two pathways** for students applying for traineeships:

1. **Nomination under a valid agreement**
If your home university nominates you through the **Nomination Web**, you must follow the same steps described in the section “**Exchange for studies.**”
2. **Students from Erasmus+ institutions without a valid agreement**
If your institution holds an **Erasmus Charter for Higher Education (ECHE)** but does not have a traineeship agreement with UiT, you must apply through this website: [🌐 Erasmus+ Guest Traineeships at UiT](#)

<p>Visa</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Nordic citizens (Denmark, Finland, Iceland, Sweden): No visa required. • EU/EEA citizens: Must register as an EU/EEA national after arriving in Norway if staying longer than 3 months. • Non-EU/EEA citizens: A student visa is required, even if the student holds a valid Schengen residence permit. <p>For full details, please visit: 🌐 Visa and immigration requirements for incoming exchange students at UiT</p>
<p>Insurance</p>	<p>UiT The Arctic University of Norway does not provide insurance for accident, liability, health, or travel.
