Quick facts:

- Your home institution needs to send a nomination to us
- Fill in the Application Form - this will be sent to you after the nomination
- In the application form you need to upload the following:
 - Transcripts of records
 - A copy of your passport
 - A copy of your European Health Insurance Card
 - A personal declaration. This document should state that you have sufficient funds to support yourself while in Norway. This should be no less than NOK 91 014 for the fall semester or NOK 75 845 for the spring semester.
 - A passport photo
 - Learning Agreement
- Please note that there's another application procedure for Erasmus students that come from outside Europe.

LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY REQUIREMENTS

Courses for exchange students are carried out in English, and we expect that nominated students have sufficient fluency in English in order to study. Students are required to have a minimum of level B2 for all courses offered to exchange students.

Level B2 (CEFR) is equivalent to IELTS minimum score: 5.0 or TOEFL minimum score: 60.

The language requirements do not apply to students with English as their first language. We consider the nomination from a partner institution as confirmation of the students' English proficiency at level B2.
