Program Structure	Exchange students are recommended to maintain full time study status with 12-15 AU credits per term. In reference to the European Credit Transfer System (ECTS), 15 Algoma University credits is equal to 30 ECTS.
Credit Information	Algoma University follows an independent credit system. Each course is 3 AU credits with a recommended term of 15 AU Credits.
