#### **Background:**

The members of the Board are elected by the Assembly from slates of nominees prepared by the Nominations Committee. Nominations may also be made by any member representative at any Assembly in which a Board election takes place. In Board elections, the aim shall be to seek a gender balance and a regional distribution of members, where at least one member shall be from an Arctic Indigenous people within the Circumpolar North.

On candidate evaluations: UArctic's Nominations Committee members discussed strategies for filling vacancies, identified existing gaps and needs, and invited identified individuals. Following an evaluation of potential candidates, Committee members prepared a final slate of the following nomination candidate. The Nominations Committee decided to leave three vacancies open in the Board.

#### **Nominated Candidate:**

**Lesley Brown** Dr. Lesley Brown is the President and Vice-Chancellor of Yukon University. She

holds an extensive experience from administrative and leadership positions in academic and research operations of Canadian universities, and as an

accomplished scholar in the field of kinesiology.
